1. Officer Terms

2. Compulsories (VOTE) No Discussion – Did not PASS

A. To REMOVE compulsories from High School Gymnastics.
 *If this passes it will not go into effect until next year 2012 – 2013.

3. State Meet (VOTE)

A. San Angelo HS has submitted a bid for the 2012 State Meet. This bid includes a two day meet done between April 12th – April 14th. Did not PASS – Tony Walker is checking to make sure that they will be able to do a three day meet. Board decided to put vote on hold to see what they can do.

Rockwall High School – Another bid for a three day meet (April 12, 13 and 14).

*If A <u>PASSES</u> then we move onto voting for either a or b. If A <u>FAILS</u> then move to B.

- a. Two day meet, April 12th (Compulsory) & 13th (Optional).
- b. Two day meet, April 13th (Compulsory) & 14th (Optional).
- B. Open the floor for other bids.
- 4. Injury Petition (VOTE)
 - A. To remove the petition Coaches will no longer be able to petition a gymnast in to the State Meet. PASSED

*We will only vote on B if A FAILS.

- B. Only allow coaches to petition seniors in to the State Meet.
- Penalty for not having an All Around contestant. (VOTE) PASSED *Gymnast must touch for score "0."

- A. The penalty for not having a designated All Around contestant will lead to a Team Forfeit.
 *Make sure that when you turn in Roster that you highlight/designate an All Around contestant.
- 6. Foreign Exchange Student (VOTE) PASSED
 - A. The proper paperwork will be filled out and turned into the Region Chairman who will then present it to the President. The President will then present the paperwork to the Review Board for approval. A foreign exchange student must receive approval by the Review Board (which consists of Athletic Directors) by the team registration deadline (November 15th). If a coach chooses to compete a non approved foreign exchange student then a penalty will be applied. The coach must write a letter stating that he/she has competed a non approved foreign exchange student and then send it in to the President for record. The penalty for this action is your team will forfeit the season.

*There will be a place on the team registration form for coach to check foreign exchange student.

- 7. Stipend for National Lead Coach (VOTE) PASSED
 - A. \$500 per diem to use for travel, food, hotel, etc.
- 8. Coaching Attire needs to be enforced
 - A. List of what NOT to wear and if a coach decides to not follow dress code then it will be up to the meet host or RC to remove coach from gym floor.
